



OUTREACH GUIDE

How to Contact Organizations for Volunteer Opportunities

As a JustServe Club, you represent JustServe in your community. Organizations want to hear from you, they love sharing their mission and helping others understand how they serve.

When contacting organizations:

- Ask what opportunities they have for a group or club like yours.
- Find out what requirements are needed to participate.
- Gather as many details as you can.

You Might Consider:

- Requesting a site visit to learn more about their work.
- Inviting them to visit your club and share about their mission.

Tips:

- Organizations enjoy talking about their mission and who they serve—this is a great way to start the conversation.
- It's okay to be selective, choose projects that align with your club's goals.
- If something isn't a good fit, thank them for their time and let them know you'd love to consider them for a future project.
- Many school email accounts can't receive replies outside of the district, include an alternate email for them to respond.

Phone Prompts:

With a Specific Opportunity:

General Inquiry:
