Starting and leading a club can bring up questions. Here are simple answers to help students move forward and figure things out. There is flexibility to adapt the club to fit each school and its unique circumstances.

WHY START A JUSTSERVE CLUB?

HOW OFTEN DOES THE CLUB MEET?

There are no set requirements. Each club decides what works best. Many clubs meet monthly, with flexibility for additional service activities.

WHAT TYPES OF PROJECTS CAN WE DO?

Clubs can participate in a wide variety of service opportunities, including local, ongoing, and event-based projects. Activities can be simple and completed during a meeting or planned over time.

DO PROJECTS HAVE TO COME FROM JUSTSERVE?
